Why Berlin?

While 2022 has been marked by the hope that the pandemic crisis will subside, it has also highlighted the need for a multilateral approach to international issues, including geopolitical relations, in the interests of peace and security. The annual G7 meeting – to be held from June 26 to 28, 2022 under the German Presidency – will be an opportunity for members to propose innovative and effective solutions. Chancellor Olaf Scholz has consequently dedicated this summit to two major challenges: tackling the climate crisis and promoting global equity.

This year, the Women's Forum will gather its international community in Berlin on June 20–21, 2022. We will bring together high-level representatives from public institutions, the private sector and international organisations, as well as more than 200 participants, all leading figures from G7 countries.

Drawing on their insights into the current global challenges the world faces, we will together propose concrete actions in a Call to Action, to be presented to G7 leaders, aimed at building strong, resilient, sustainable, balanced and inclusive growth for the future.



Our Initiatives in Berlin

Women's Forum Youth Voices - June 20

The Women's Forum will bring together 30 influential young people from G7 countries to participate in our Youth Workshop, where they will be divided into 5 working groups according to the 5 themes of our Berlin programme: Climate, Health, Gender Biases, Future of Work and Feminist Diplomacy. A small selection of them will earn the chance to present their messages and priorities on stage the next day!

Women's Forum CEO Champions - June 21

On the 21st, we will have a private CEO Champions meeting. Launched in 2010, CEO Champions is an iconic initiative of the Women's Forum for the Economy & Society, which aims to foster progress and accountability in the advancement of women in the private and public sectors. This peer-to-peer network provides a unique opportunity for CEOs to share best practices and experiences and highlight their organization's commitment to the advancement of women in the workforce.
