Hit the trails for a hike through Kamloops' desert-like valley where wide-open grasslands, fragrant sagebrush, ponderosa pine forests, deep gorges, sandstone canyons, and chiseled hoodoos frame every adventure. From laid-back paths to rugged terrain, there's a route here that's perfect for whatever challenge calls.

Kenna Cartwright Nature Park

Kenna Cartwright Park is one of BC's largest municipal parks, covering nearly 800 hectares of land and featuring over 40 kilometres (25 miles) of trails popular with hikers, trail runners, and mountain bikers. There are benches and picnic tables throughout the park where you can stop and enjoy the breathtaking views of Kamloops and the Thompson Valley. Kenna is delightful at any time of year and is dog-friendly off-leash.

Peterson Creek Nature Park

Peterson Creek Nature Park is situated in the heart of the city along a natural creek corridor. The park encompasses almost 100 hectares and features over 10 km of trails. Trails vary in difficulty, largely influenced by elevation change, and offer something for every skill level. Peterson Creek is widely used during the summer months, is off-leash dog-friendly, and features a remarkable view of the downtown core.

The Dallas-Barnhartvale Nature Park

The Dallas-Barnhartvale Nature Park connects the Barnhartvale and Dallas communities through a series of trails in the grassland landscape. Take in views along the South Thompson River as you admire the silt cliffs below.

Lac du Bois Grasslands

Lac du Bois Grasslands is a sprawling park with sweeping views of the Thompson Valley and panoramic views of Kamloops Lake and the Thompson River. Hike some of the most popular trails among locals, including Battle

Bluff, Dewdrop, and Cinnamon Ridge. If you're lucky, you might even see the local California Bighorn Sheep.

Valleyview Nature Park

High above the silt bluffs of the Valleyview community, explore the trails of the Valleyview Nature Park as you wind through the fragrant desert sagebrush. A variety of trails allow you to discover the hidden beauty of this small municipal park. You might even catch a glimpse of mountain bikers tackling the Kamloops terrain in the Kamloops Bike Ranch next door.

Kamloops is home to unique, geographical landscapes including sagebrush, grasslands, and hoodoos. See hoodoos formed by volcanic rock or view silt bluffs from a glacial lake.

CRARD DERD AND AWESOME



East Shuswap Road


The silt plateau that sits above the East Shuswap Road is the remains of what was once the floor of an ancient glacial lake. Near the end of the Ice Age, glacier ice filled the North Thompson Valley and waters were temporarily dammed in the South Thompson Valley, forming a glacial lake. The silt-rich glacial meltwater, derived from glacier grinding on rock, settled to the lake floor and over time tens of meters of sediment accumulated. Eventually the glacier receded, releasing the lake waters and re-establishing the South Thompson River. The river cut a valley through the soft silt, leaving the old lake floor high and dry, as benchlands of silt. A drive along East Shuswap Road gives you the best views of these silt bluffs and hoodoos.


Cinnamon Ridge

Cinnamon Ridge Hoodoos are the eroded remains of an ancient volcano that erupted in the area 50 million years ago. The weathering of volcanic rocks released iron that stained the rock a cinnamon brown colour, giving the ridge its name. A trail will bring you closer to the hoodoos and through the old stream bed that carved slot-like canyons through the volcanic rock.

Dallas-Barnhartvale Nature Park

Just off Highway 1 East, the Dallas-Barnhartvale Nature Park is home to silt bluffs, formed by the same glacial lake that formed the hoodoos along East Shuswap Road. Hike through the silt bluffs to the top of the benchlands for a view overlooking the South Thompson River Valley.





Kamloops' rugged terrain was built for biking. Take your pick between cross-country trails or more technical downhill runs and explore grasslands, rolling sagebrush hills, and pine forests. There's something here for every skill level, and with four-season riding, you can bike any time of the year.

Cross-Country Trails

Pineview Valley is home to 50 km of trails through pine trees that range from green to black diamond and one double black diamond. Explore the wide array of cross-country climbs and fun, flowy descents.


If you're new to mountain biking or an intermediate rider, Lac du Bois Grasslands offers an ideal place to ride with 20 km of cross-country trails. Be rewarded with views of Kamloops and the Thompson Valley as you climb and descend through the sage-scented grasslands.

Venture through pine trees and sagebrush at Kenna Cartwright Park. The trails are draped over and around a hilltop that overlooks the city with many routes to get your sweat on. With 46 well-marked trails for different skill levels, this park is ideal for beginner and intermediate riders.

Downhill Trails

Harper Mountain is an all-mountain, downhill freeride playground. Known for its more advanced technical trails, this area also offers some intermediate trails. Either climb your way up the Ket-R-Done trail or the shuttle road, or shuttle to the top with a 4x4 vehicle.

Sun Peaks Bike Park offers 40 lift-accessed mountain bike trails up 2,000 vertical feet. Level Up is the easiest trail in the bike park. This 9 km green trail is ideal for entry-level riders, kids, and families who want to try lift-access biking for the first time. Learn the basics of mountain biking in the Bike Skills Park. Bike instructors and coaches are available daily.



Sun Peaks Bike Park

Experience the best of lift-accessed riding with a huge network of trails for all ability levels, from the Progression Park built for beginners, to machine-built flow and jump trails and the technical singletrack Sun Peaks is famous for, you'll find endless trail combinations on the mountain.



Located at the convergence of two major rivers and surrounded by lakes, Kamloops has water sports and activities for all ages. So paddle, swim, boat or cast a line on one of Kamloops' 100+ fishing lakes.

Riverside Park

Located downtown on the South Thompson River, Riverside Park holds the top spot in the summer and shoulder seasons for beach access. The beach has a playground, waterpark, tennis and pickleball courts, lawn bowling, and marked swimming areas. In July and August, it's the home of Music in the Park with free live music every night.

Kamloops Lake

The biggest body of water 15 minutes west of Kamloops on Highway 1. With Bruker Marina & Beach Club right on Kamloops Lake, it makes it easy to enjoy a day on the water.

Pioneer Park

A short walk down the Rivers Trail from Riverside Park, this locals' favourite park has change rooms, washrooms, picnic tables, and park benches. It's also a great beach for volleyball or playing fetch with your dog.

Overlander Park Beach

Located on the North Shore where the North and South Thompson Rivers meet, Overlander Park Beach is the largest in Kamloops, dog friendly, and perfect for the family. It's also great for skimboarding and beach volleyball.

Paul Lake Provincial Park

A popular day-use area 30 minutes from Kamloops. Home to a beach and cartop boat launch. This lake is popular for kayaking and stand-up paddleboarding.

Lac Le Jeune Provincial Park

Located just 30 minutes from Kamloops, the day-use area at this park features 146 meters of sandy beach for swimming but is also a perfect spot to launch your water craft. The park has a designated boat launch and fishing dock.



Bruker Marina & Beach Club

Bruker Marina features a public boat launch, and beach area, a fuel dock, convenience store, and various motor-sport and water rentals. The beach, boat launch, and play area are open to everyone, with a daily fee that includes parking. The marina is open from May 1st until October.

Kamloops Lake Launch Point: Bruker Marina at Tobiano, Savona, or Cooney Bay on Kamloops' North Shore.

Paul Lake Provincial Park Launch Point: West end of the lake or from the day-use parking area.

Lac Le Jeune Provincial Park Launch Point: Anywhere along the day-use parking area.

McConnell Lake Launch Point: Gravel boat launch in the parking area.



HOOKED

Fishing in Kamloops is available year-round with spring and fall months offering the most consistent open water fishing options. Good fishing is also available during the warm summer months at higher elevation lakes, and early winter provides great ice fishing conditions as the fish are still actively feeding.

Many lakes receive annual stockings of Rainbow Trout, Brook Trout and Kokanee while several large lake systems including Shuswap, Adams and Kamloops Lake are home to wild stocks of Rainbow Trout, Bull Trout, Lake Trout and Kokanee.

Carve into champagne powder or cross-country ski by moonlight. Pedal your bike through winding trails, venture by snowshoe to parts unexplored, or strap on your ice skates for a friendly game of shinny. There's snow much fun within a one-hour drive of the city.

Resort & Ski Areas

Winter snowfall in the Kamloops region is renowned for being light, dry, and powdery. From mid-November to mid-April, skiers and snowboarders have a variety of terrain ranging from beginner greens to double black diamonds at Harper Mountain and Sun Peaks Resort. The long ski season, accessibility to local mountains, and affordability makes Kamloops a popular destination for downhill skiing and snowboarding.

Harper Mountain

This small-scale ski resort has nostalgic charm. Just a short drive from Kamloops, this family-friendly hill includes a lift operated tube park, ski & snowboard terrain park, nordic and snowshoe trails. Shred some laps after work and go night skiing from Thursday to Saturday 5pm to 9pm. Warm up by the bonfires or enjoy the locals' favourite mulled wine inside the lodge.

Snowshoeing

From mid-December to the end of March, the hills around Kamloops are blanketed in snow providing dozens of trails to snowshoe. Pack a thermos and make a day out of it or break in a snowy trail one afternoon under sunny skies.

Enjoy panoramic views within city parks including Kenna Cartwright Park and Peterson Creek Nature Park. Both have trails for every experience level.

Lac Le Jeune and surrounding areas are a popular spot for snowshoers. Diverse trails follow around lakes including McConnell Lake, Walloper Lake, Bush Lake, and Dogwood Marshes.

Upload on the chairlift or snowshoe your way to the top to enjoy views of the Thompson Valley at Harper Mountain.

Stake Lake Trails offer a great family-friendly destination with over 13 km of trails. Dogs are welcome in some areas. Rentals are available.







Cross-Country Trails

Kamloops is home to a network of renowned cross-country ski trails for beginners to experienced skiers. Visit Stake Lake Trails, Harper Mountain and Sun Peaks Resort to explore the pristine trails.

Ice Skating

The winter months are the perfect time for ice skating with friends and family. Experience one of Canada's iconic winter activities and skate outside on a frozen lake or rink.

Glide on popular frozen lakes such as Inks Lake, Albert McGowan Park, and Little Heffley Lake. Follow ice safety and stay off the ice if conditions aren't great. Skate indoors at one of the city operated arenas. Visit kamloops.ca for scheduled times and locations.



Winter Biking

As the birthplace of freeride mountain biking, Kamloops makes riding outdoors year-round a reality. Fat biking and winter biking have gained popularity and there are a couple of riding areas to choose from if you want to see what it's all about.


