Mixed grassland system (Milk sheep, milk cows & arable)
Partnership with employees

Background

- Family farm since 3 generations (Parents) with milk cows
- 1991 start of milk sheep activity & employment of 1st farm employee
- 2001-Creation of GAEC when 3 sons set up as farmers with increase in milk cow activity to 150 cows and the milk sheep activity to 350 ewes)



Geographic-climate context

Height above sea level 300m Soil quality varies between the two sites (acid soil)



Farmland 330ha

(25% in floodable zone) 140 ha of perm pasture 70 ha of temp pasture 65 ha of cereals 35 ha of maize silage 20 ha of grain maize



ITT

Sheep flock

360 Lacaune milking ewes in total for 300 ewes milked

70,000 litres of milk = 240 litres/ewe milked from January to July/September
Milk sold to Terre-Dieu dairy

1 lambing/ewe/year

75% lambings

Prolificity 1.6 lambs per ewe / 1.3 lambs for ewe lambs

15 August Ewes Al'd with Lacaune semen for future flock replacements

20 September Ewe lambs Al'd with Suffolk semen

Charollais rams to sweep up any failed Al's

At grass from 15 March just after the peak in lactation until end October

Finishing of lambs (37-42kg liveweight)
Sales through the co-operative Coopagno
