
THE FARM

The Charolais is the local and historic breed on our farm. It does well here, and the carcass yields well. It makes good use of the available fodder and is docile.

The selection criteria are,

- Easy calving
- Suitability for calving
- Maternal qualities
- Fine bones

- Rearer finisher system

290 ha of farmland

- 46 ha of cereals
- 12 ha of maize silage
- 70 ha of temporary pasture
- 108 ha of permanent pasture
