## **GAEC CANTE**

In 1998, Jean Pierre took on the family farm. In 2017, Valentin joined his father, creating GAEC Cante (2 full-time staff).

Jean Pierre has performance tested since the early 2000's. He began registering his entire herd with the HBC in 2010. Passionate as he is about the Charolais, registration with the Herd-Book was the natural way of continuing the work he had started. "Since Valentin joined me on the farm, now a GAEC, we've been able to pursue our genetic improvement work, show our animal at competitions and sell young bulls as breeding stock."

## Farm management

190 hectares of farmland, including 30 hectares of crops used to feed the herd.

- Cattle unit: 95 Charolais calves
- Poultry unit: 1 building of 150 m2 for meat poultry
- Wild game unit: breeding & rearing wild boar, sold at 25 to 50 kg liveweight.
