Farm history

A family farm

1990: Laurent DETOUR set up as a farmer in a GAEC

with his father.

1991: Construction of a milk cattle building. 1995: Laurent's brother joins the GAEC.

1998: Laurent's father retires and is replaced by

Laurent's wife.

2006: Construction of a suckler beef building. 2015: Laurent's sister-in-law joins the GAEC

Laurent is planning to retire soon.





Farm description

An extensively managed farm

- 4 partners + 1 employee ½ time (Laurent's nephew)
- Milk activity 45 cows of which 35 are Normande + 10 Holsteins
- Suckler beef activity 150 Charolais & Limousin cows
- Sheep activity 60 Suffolk & Charollais sheep
- 230 hectares, of which
 - 200 ha of grassland
 - 8 ha of maize
 - 22 ha of cereals

Sale of bull calves at 3 weeks of age Age at first calving - 32 months









The Normande herd



Cows

- Grazing in paddocks from the end of March to early November.
- Maize silage, grass silage, plus cake as from September and throughout winter.

All heifers reared on the farm

Average yield/cow 6000 kg, 4.35% fats & 3.50% proteins

Bull selection criteria

• Milk, Fats & Proteins, Legs, Low mastitis rate

Bulls currently used for breeding

• SESAME, TUPACAMARU, TOUTATIS, THEIX, TALENSAC, etc.
