## The Cyanotype technique

The Cyanotype technique (also known as sunprinting or blueprinting) was discovered in 1842 and was one of the earliest techniques to reproduce images. Biologist Anna Atkins was the first to use this technique a lot and is now seen as the first female photographer ever. Printers all around started to use the sunprinting technique, sometimes right on their doorstep.



### Do it yourself in just 3 easy steps:

1. Treat and dry watercolour paper with the magic photo agents
2. Expose in the sunlight with something beautiful
3. Rinse and dry :)
