A long-standing heritage at Château d'Astros

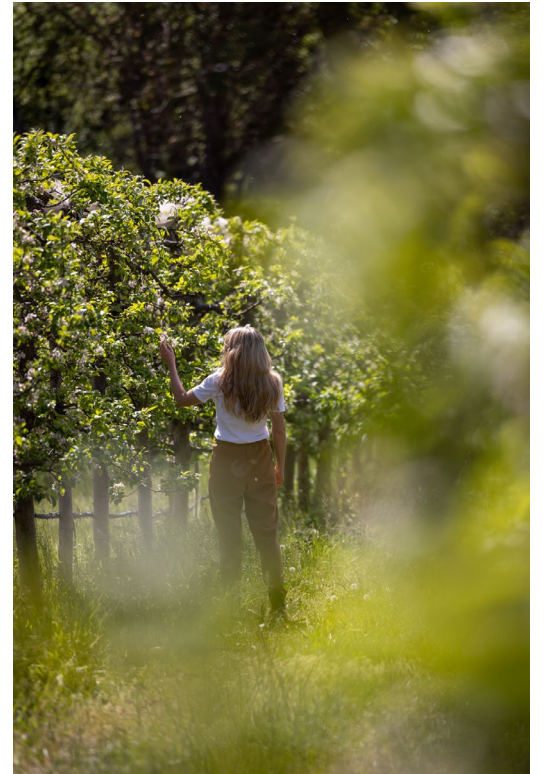
For over 50 years, apples have been a core part of Château d'Astros' agricultural identity.

Today, Château d'Astros is **investing in a large-scale orchard regeneration program to preserve and future-proof this heritage** in response to climate and agricultural challenges.
