

# **Rules**

## **Participation and registration:**

Hackathon is opened to any Cegid employees. Each Cegid employees can register to hackathon:

- either in proposing a subject matter
- or joining a team

## Team make-up:

Each team will be made up of 4 to 6 participants with a required minimum number of 2 developers and a maximum number of 1 UX/UI designer or 1 data scientist.

## **Team selection:**

The number of participants is limited to 100 employees, the first registers will get priority if their team make-up is compliant and the subject matter is validated by Organising Committee.

The subject matter should result in the enhancement of existing product or the creation of new product.

The Organising Committee will confirm hackathon participation to registers.

## Hackathon deliverable:

Each team will get 24 hours maximum to design and complete its project.

Each team will have to complete 2 deliverables:

- Project summary: problem to solve, solution proposal, data required, embedded technology, user profil (personae), industry...

- Prototype/functional mock-up running on development language and/or algorithm and/or third-party applications, for whom source code will be host on AzureDevOps Repo.

The teams will pitch their project during 10 minutes in front of hackathon jury and participants.

#### Hackathon jury :

The jury will be made of Organising committee.

#### **Prizes and Awards:**

4 awards :

- Creativity award
- Useful innovation award
- Business award
- Special jury award

A team can receive only one unique award. The jury will perform the selection of winner teams based on the following criteria:

- Relevance and response to real customer need (usefulness/added value)
- Feasibility and fast implementation (rapid go to market)
- Pitch quality (clearness, dynamism, originality)

The amount of each prize is 1000€, this amount will be divided into equal part between each winner team members.
