



The EcoVadis Methodology and Assessment Model

EcoVadis rates sustainability performance by assessing a company's policies, actions and results, as well as inputs from third-party professionals and external sources. Companies are required to provide supporting evidence which we verify to ensure the results are valid and accurate.

Our methodology is based on a framework of 21 sustainability criteria mapped to global standards, and is guided by an international scientific committee.



Companies receive scorecards covering four theme areas:
