
For nine generations, our family has been crafting wines in the South of France, along the Mediterranean coast.


Nestled on the slopes of an ancient volcano, we benefit from a unique terroir that shapes the character of our wines.

AOP Faugères
Carignan, Syrah

This cuvée comes from old Carignan vines planted in 1929 and affectionately nicknamed “la Vieille”. The plot is located in the middle of the scrubland (full oak, arbutus, rockrose, thyme, rosemary...) where the wild boar reigns supreme. Each year they enjoy many of these magnificent grapes. And we vinify what remains traditionally, with daily pump overs and 15 day vatting. Then we blend it with a little Syrah from the same area.

A rare schist soil, very low yields and deeply rooted old vines give all the depth and balance to this wine. Frère et Soeur comes from our most beautiful plots.
