This 3-month online coaching offers visibility and access to an ecosystem of stakeholders to develop the sustainable business. Taught in English, the program is open to startups from around the world.

The winners will present their projects at the Global meeting to be held in Paris on November 28 and 29, 2023.

In addition to financial support from Bank of America, WomenEntrepreneurs4Good will benefit from the firm's expertise in the form of mentoring for the program's participants and hosting masterclasses. Vanessa Holtz is personally playing an active role in this initiative as a member of the Grand Jury selecting the finalists for the program.
