Press Release N°1 - December 2024



On December the 10th in Paris the chair of AXEMA, The syndicate of agricultural machinery manufacturers, and the President of AgriSIMA presented the outlines of the new french and european meeting for agricultural production to the press and the agricultural equipment sector.

The core principles of the international trade fair include a return to fundamentals to attract a targeted audience, high-quality themed content, enhanced conviviality, and controlled exhibition costs. It will be held every two years and will take place in the Parc Des Expositions de Villepinte in February 2026.

« France, the leading country for agricultural equipment in Europe and the 2nd most technological sector in the world after aeronautics, has a duty to develop an event highlighting the excellence of its agriculture. After SIMA 2022, which fell short of the sector's expectations, and SIMA 2024, which was cancelled due to the agricultural crisis, it is our responsibility to offer solutions that meet the needs of both exhibitors and visitors »

With this in mind, **AXEMA** has joined forces with **Frédéric Bondoux**, Chair of Profield Events (Salon de l'Herbe et des Fourrages, Salonvert, Salon des ETA, etc.)

Their shared goal is to build on SIMA's legacy while introducing a fresh concept and new ambitions, putting the farmer at the center of the trade fair.

AgriSIMA will take place over 4 days, **from Sunday, the 22nd to Wednesday, the 25th of February 2026.** at the same time as **SIA** (Salon International de l'Agriculture) at the **Parc Des Expositions de Paris-Villepinte.**

In an agriculture that is rapidly changing, **AgriSIMA** will be strongly focused on the actors in agricultural production: heads of arable farms and mixed farmers, managers of CUMA (Farm Machinery Cooperative), service providers and ETA (Agriculture and Forestry Entrepreneurs), distributors of agricultural equipment, cooperatives, merchants and international visitors.

The Trade Fair, which will include Halls 4, 5a, 5b and 6, i.e. a surface area of 150,000 m², will highlight different sectors, each with specific content:

- An eclectic schedule (conferences, presentation of studies, seminars, round tables, European forums and specific events)
- AgriSIMA Awards prize winners...

In a weakened economic context, the organisers would like to be ecoresponsible and are committed to meticulous management with the aim of reducing the global cost of organising the Trade Fair by 30%. They are counting on the pooling of a certain number of purchases and a rental offer per m² of -20% compared with 2022.
