

Here you will find all measures in place to ensure that the event takes place in the best possible conditions:

- 1** Wearing a mask is mandatory for all participants of the event (organization team, exhibitors, visitors and all service providers).
- 2** Control for the flow of people in and out of the buildings and dedicated rooms in accordance with the safety regulations are adopted.
- 3** The sanitary facilities are sized according to the capacity of the facility. They are provided in sufficient quantity for hand washing, depending on the number of visitors.
- 4** The frequency of cleaning of the premises and toilets, with traceability, is adapted and reinforced.
- 5** A sufficient supply of soaps, gels or hydroalcoholic solutions for staff, organisers and the public is ensured.
- 6** A rigorous system for dealing with symptomatic people is put in place and will be updated if necessary.
- 7** A health risk referent for the event, specific to the site and the organiser, is appointed and is present throughout the exhibition with daily updates.
- 8** A legal watch is kept on regulations and government measures. Postings and information are distributed to permanent and temporary staff in contact with the public and measures are applied.
- 9** The hygiene and sanitary measures are coordinated with all the companies, venues and service providers involved in the event.
- 10** Revision of reception capacities in accordance with the official rules on physical distance and the size of the people in m² in the conference rooms and workshop areas.

Barrier actions to protect yourself and protect others



Wear a mask at the exhibition



Keep a distance of one metre from others



**Wash your hands very regularly with soap
or hydro-alcoholic gel**



Cough and sneeze into your elbow or into a tissue



Greet without shaking hands, avoid hugging



Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands



Use a single-use tissue and throw it away after use
