## Admissions

The following steps will quide you through your application process.

#### 1. Pre-application Assessment

#### 3. Complete and Submit Your Application Form

The following documents are required during application: Two letters of recommendation; Colour copies of identity documents; Colour copies of degree(s) either in English or Chinese; Original copies of official transcripts with grades from all universities attended. #### 4. Assessment Options

Applicants are required to submit a GMAT or a GMAC Executive Assessment score followed by an interview, or complete a TIEMBA admissions test from INSEAD or Tsinghua. In case of the latter, applicants must submit a complete application at least two weeks before the preferred TIEMBA admission test.

#### Additional Info

Chinese Nationals from Mainland China who wish to enroll in an EMBA programme are required by the Ministry of Education, China, to take the National Entrance Exam. You will have to obtain a Conditional Acceptance Letter from both INSEAD and Tsinghua University before registering online for the National Entrance Exam in October each year. The actual exam will take place at Tsinghua University in December each year. We encourage interested applicants to submit their applications early to ensure timely registration of the entrance exam.

We operate a rolling admission process, offering you the choice of four deadlines. We recommend applying as early as possible, and applications will be evaluated as they are submitted.

For reference, the application deadlines for the class starting in September 2022 are:

## **Chinese Language Course**

A Chinese Language course is compulsory for international participants who come to China to undertake a master degree, unless one of the exemptions below applies.

### Exemptions

Round

Participants who have already learnt the Chinese language may be exempted with any of these proofs of language proficiency:

- Provide Chinese Proficiency Test Certificate: HSK Level 6: A minimum score of 80 in Listening, 70 in Reading and 60 in Writing. Test must be obtained no earlier than September 2020.
- Provide Degree Certificate obtained in China and taught entirely in Chinese.

#### **Tuition Fees**

The tuition fees for the current intake are US\$125,000. Fees are subject to change. Please refer to the **TIEMBA financing page** on the INSEAD website for the latest updates. Most participants fund their programme with a combination of personal savings, family support, sponsorship by an employer, scholarships and loans. As TIEMBA is a dual degree programme, you will receive invoices from both schools. Fees payable to INSEAD are inclusive of the prevailing GST.
