Delegates from countries that require visas to enter Viet Nam are responsible for their own visa and visa application. • International delegates are not required to provide proof of vaccination or negative SARS-CoV-2 test results upon entry. Please note that in case of worsening pandemic situation in Viet Nam, new regulations may be applied and will be updated via registered emails to all delegates.

10. Additional information

• *Climate and weather*: October is the last autumn month of the year and generally considered the most favourable time to visit the city. The weather feels pleasant during day time and cool breeze at night, with the temperature ranging from 22 to 29 Celcius degree. Sudden rains are less common so it feels drier. Humidity is 74% on average.

• **Currency and currency exchange**: The official currency in Viet Nam is Viet Nam Dong (VND) and can be exchanged at airports. Credit cards are also widely accepted in most commercial facilities (restaurants, shopping malls, etc.)

*Exchange rates for information only: 1 USD = 24,000.00 VND.

• **Telecommunication:** Mobifone, Viettel and Vinaphone are three largest mobile network operators in Viet Nam. 4G/5G Connections are available. SIM cards are available at airports.
