What's the issue ?

Local (Skellefteå/Sweden) /European & Global issue:

- Gigafactories for the batteries & EV value chain!
- 15000 new jobs in Skellefteå (now 73000 inhab.) by 2025 (Northvolt Ett, Li-ion cell production)
- This will happen in ca 40 other locations in **Europe** in a few years to come; Skellefteå is just a first pilot!

Northvolt Ett (One)



- **High requirements:** relevant experience, training and social skills for machine operators & technicians.
- Industry 4.0 plant Automation/Internet of things/Machine learning

About...



- 4-5000 direct jobs
- ≈75-80% are blue-collar jobs (machine operators, technicians, logistics etc)
- + 3000? supplier/ subcontractor jobs
- + services, public sector
- Prediction: ≈ 15 000 new jobs (public/private).
- Skellefteå (73 000) & low unemployment on an area ≈1/3 of Belgium
- For 1st production line of 5+:
 > 500 persons hired, of > 50 nationalities



What's the response?



- Locally (Skellefteå): Housing projects, rapid infrastructure growth, new ed programmes, upskilling/reskilling, marketing / attractiveness /relocation /recruitment programmes
- **Europe:** Many EU/national initiatives, among them **ALBATTS** – an ERASMUS+ Blueprint project; 4 years, 20 partners in 11 countries. Skellefteå is coordinator
- <u>https://project-albatts.eu</u> is the only EC project focusing on education and training development for blue-collar workers and technicians about 75% of the overall staffing need.
